e.g. 中秋节为每年的农历八月十五。The Mid-Autumn Festival falls on the 15th day of the eighth lunar month each year.

2. 传统节日 chuántǒng jiérì - traditional festival

e.g. 中秋节在中国是仅次于春节的第二大传统节日。The Mid-Autumn Festival is the second largest traditional festival in China after the Spring Festival.

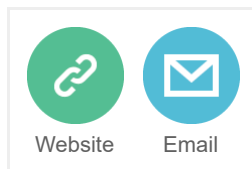
