1. 端午节 Duānwǔ jié - Dragon Boat Festival

e.g. 农历五月初五是中国传统节日端午节。The fifth day of the fifth lunar month is the Dragon Boat Festival, a traditional Chinese festival.

2. 粽子 zòngzi - zongzi (The traditional festival food for the Dragon Boat Festival is large pyramid-shaped glutinous rice dumplings wrapped in reed or bamboo leaves)

e.g. 粽子的做法不简单，可是味道很好。Zongzi is not easy to make, but it tastes very good.

3. 龙舟 lóngzhōu - dragon boat

e.g. 划龙舟是端午节的重要活动。Dragon boating is an important activity on the Dragon Boat Festival.
