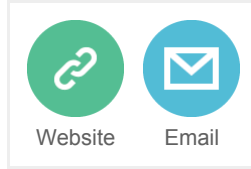
INTERNATIONAL CHINESE LANGUAGE TEACHERS SCHOLARSHIP 2021 OPEN FOR APPLICATION
